

# The InfoLink service of *Florida Entomologist*

## Purpose of service

If there is material relevant to your *Florida Entomologist* article that is too detailed or too extensive to be made part of the article's printed version, you may make it permanently available by purchasing an "InfoLink" for \$45.

## How an InfoLink works

An "InfoLink" is a hyperlink that is installed at an article's listing in the online table of contents of an issue of *Florida Entomologist* as posted on the journal's primary web server. An InfoLink *accesses a file or files permanently posted on the primary server.*

You must plan for your InfoLink before your article is composed by the printer. This is because articles with an InfoLink must have this statement immediately after the abstract:

This article has supplementary material linked to it in the table of contents for its issue at <http://www.fcla.edu/FlaEnt/fe902.htm>."

[The number near the end of the URL changes with each issue—902 means the URL is for vol. 90, no. 2 (i.e., June 2007).]

Without this statement, readers of your article are unlikely to know that an InfoLink exists or how to access it

## Preparing the file or files to be posted

If the InfoLink is to access a single file, you need only submit that file. The file need not be a file type that Web browsers can display—because users can right-click on any hyperlink and download the linked file to their computer. However, the file should of course be of a type that you expect to be easily readable far into the future. A PDF file is likely a good choice in this regard.

If the InfoLink is to access more than one file, one of the files must be the "gateway" file that has hyperlinks to the other files.. This will be the one reached by clicking on the article's InfoLink hyperlink, and Web browsers must display it so the user can easily access the other files.

## When to plan and how to purchase

You pay for an InfoLink when you pay the other charges relative to your article. Simply add the \$45 for an InfoLink as an item on the purchase order that pays the page charges. Specify the details of your InfoLink by filling out the form below.
